Folding Bike Trailer

Our folding bike trailers are designed to meet your transportation needs with ultimate convenience. They are effortlessly foldable, allowing for compact storage and easy transportation when not in use. The robust steel frame ensures a long-lasting performance and protection against the elements. The perfect addition to your biking experience!

Warnings:

- Do not load the trailer with more than 50kg
- Tyres should be inflated to 25-30PSI for maximum control, check tyre pressure before each use – use a foot pump or hand pump to inflate tyres
- Do not use the trailer to transport people
- Do not perform any technical modifications to the trailer – this can lead to road hazards and the manufacturer warranty will be void
- Periodically re-check all fasteners to ensure they are tight
- Do not use the trailer on stony roads or uneven terrain
- Do not over fill the trailer to prevent items falling out during travel

1 x Frame Body

2 x 16" Wheels

2 x Quick Release Levers

2 x Front & Back Panels

10 x Safety Reflectors

5 x Safety Pins

8 x Washers

1 x Bike Attachment Bracket

1 x Securing Strap

2 x Bolts

Assembly

Step 1

Pull up the side frames and insert front/back panels into the bracket and fix panels with a safety pin. Make sure the safety pin is locked!



Step 2

Turn the frame upside down, lift the tow bar and secure with a safety pin



Step 3

Remove conical nut from the quick release lever and remove one spring



Step 4

Insert the wheel into the frame



Place the locking washer onto the axle ensuring it is hooked into the hole in the axle



Insert the quick release into the wheel axle



Step 5

On the opposite side, place the conical spring, then the hub safety washers



Screw the conical nut in a clockwise direction on to the quick release lever to secure it



Tighten the quick release lever





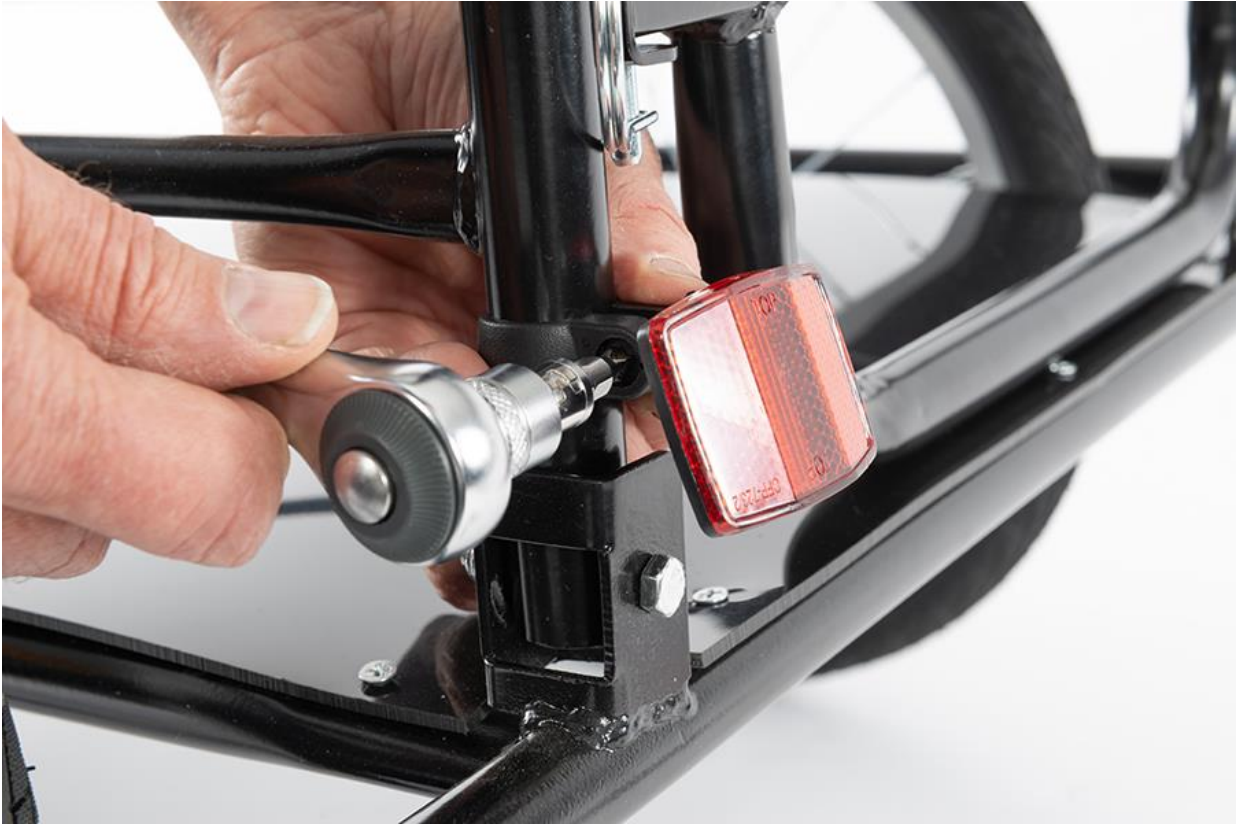
Repeat on the opposite wheel

WARNING: Wheels must be properly installed. If wheels are not properly locked into the bracket and securing lever axles are not firmly in place, then the wheels could detach. If you have any doubt before use, then please consult a specialist.

Step 6

Attach the safety reflectors





Step 7

Attach the securing strap to the tow bar, as shown below



Step 8

Attach to the bike frame, as shown below



Wrap the securing strap around the frame as much as possible and attach the clip to the strap



Safe Towing Tips:

- Make sure your bike brakes work properly, braking distance is increased when towing a trailer
- This trailer is wide – allow extra clearance near curbs, parked cars and any other obstacles
- Do not turn sharply – cycling with a trailer attached requires a wide turning radius
- Avoid curbs and pot holes
